An easy-to-use time & attendance and equipment tracking system has dramatically improved Robert Heely Construction's business, according to controller Trina Dewitt.

Robert Heely Construction, a California company, was formed in 1977 to provide quality maintenance and new construction services to the oil industry. Services provided include gang crews, A-frame crews, certified welders, backhoes, heavy and support equipment for all phases of oil field construction and maintenance.

For years they struggled to manage the company's time cards using a patchwork of inefficient spreadsheets and manual efforts. The company would manually key time card information into their in-house Master Builder system and their customer's SAP system for over 250 employees on a daily basis.

Trina then discovered mJobTime, a system designed to track time and attendance for employees and equipment. "We saved over \$31,000 a year by cutting out one data entry position," she said. "The savings resulted from the elimination of
